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## **INTRODUCTION**

Precancels, although a relatively small area amidst a sea of philatelic specialties, is supported by an immense amount of literature – possibly more than any other comparable specialty and probably more than some smaller ones. The point is not “Yea us!”, but that there is a wealth of knowledge waiting to be tapped. Even after accumulating (and reading) precancel literature for over 50 years, I still come across interesting nuggets of lost knowledge.

As this is being written, the earliest precancel publication known to exist is the 1904 Smith and Duck catalog. There may be an earlier catalog, but no surviving copy has been found (see the introduction to the Catalog Section). There are some articles in the general Philatelic literature of the late 1800s chronicling precancels, even before the name precancel was adopted. The first regularly issued periodical devoted to precancels was *The Precancel Monthly* which appeared in February 1911. More than 175 titles have appeared during the last eleven decades. Some are simple, some are loaded with information. Fortunately for users, there are indexes available for many of the meatier titles (see the introduction to the Periodicals Section)

This bibliography is intended to be a reference to what has been published. Some titles, such as Bushnell’s Magazine, are difficult to find. Others survive in reasonable quantities. Much precancel material is available in Philatelic libraries.

This bibliography is limited to purely precancel publications. It is also limited to print publications, as opposed to those purely digital or databases. With few exceptions, only items actually seen are included.

As detailed in the Table of Contents, the material included in this bibliography is broken down into five sections. Editorial decisions about how to classify a particular item were not always clear cut. It is hoped that these decisions have created the least confusion possible.

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## **INTRODUCTION**

Although there were some earlier articles in philatelic periodicals which contained lists of precancels, the earliest catalog found to date is the one published in 1904 by F. L. Smith and George F. Duck. Until something earlier is found (see page 1-18), Smith and Duck have the distinction of having published the earliest surviving precancel catalog.

In the eleven plus ensuing decades, hundreds of precancel catalogs and checklists have been published by collectors, dealers and organizations. These covered Bureaus, as well as a variety of local precancel areas: Towns, Types, General and a myriad of ways to collect subsets of locals. Among these are double Line electros, coils, classics, Washington-Franklin issues, Washington Bicentennials and many others. There are also numerous catalogs covering precancels from countries other than the United States. There are possibly as many ways to collect as there are collectors.

Precancels may be the best cataloged of philatelic specialties. Bureaus had annual catalogs for many years. Other areas had perhaps only a single catalog for many years, and copies were treasured (think the Hoover black book), until finally replaced by a modern update. The last twenty years have been a boom period with the publication of many catalogs, and the development of data bases that have added so many features to precancel collecting.

This section of the bibliography is presented in eight parts, in most cases alphabetically by topic, and broken down to sub-topics when needed. Listings are generally chronological, except for a few cases where multiple publishers overlapped, date-wise.

This bibliography is limited to material made available in print form; items existing as databases only were intentionally omitted, the two exceptions being the PSS Handstamp Control Database and the PSS Printed Dated Control Database. In a few cases, publications made available in only PDF form are included.

## GENERAL CATALOGS AND CHECKLISTS

**COMPILER'S NOTE:** There are references in the literature to two early precancel catalogs of which copies are unknown. The first, which predates any listed below, is said to have been published in September 1903 by Walter Gates. This catalog is referred to in detail in an article in the April 25, 1925, issue of the Weekly Philatelic Gossip; because of the detail of the description, the compiler is inclined to believe it is reliable. According to the article, the catalog was titled “A Reference and Check-list of the Pre-canceled Stamps of the United States”. The second catalog is described in an article by Howard Starr Dickey in the September 20, 1952, issue of Stamps magazine. He mentions a precancel catalog printed in 1907 in Stillwater, Oklahoma. No other significant details are given, but it should be noted that Clarence Dalton of Stillwater was active in the Precancelled Stamp Club at that time. A review of the minutes book of that club did not yield any information on a catalog.

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The Bushnell catalogs were apparently hand assembled, over a period of several years, as the demand arose. The result is a number of variations in the format and appearance. Because these are early and of special interest to some collectors, the variations are described below in detail.

The most notable variation in the Bushnell 7-part catalog series is the number of album page sections offered in the ads contained in the catalog. Also, the color of the cover stock changed from red to green starting with section 4 which comes in both colors. It changed again to a lighter weight pinkish stock for sections six and seven. The catalogs have been observed with both round and square corners on the right edge. The list below records all variations seen to date.

IFC=inside front cover; IBC=inside back cover; OBC=outside back cover; numbers refer to number of album sections offered in the ads.

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## INTRODUCTION

Probably no specialized area of US Philately has more periodical publications than the field of precancels. Beginning with *The Precancel Monthly* in 1911, the last eleven decades more than 175 titles have appeared. Some lasted for only a single issue, others 80 years or more. Some contain vast amounts of information; others were simple club newsletters. For those who can find access to them, they provide many hours of interesting reading.

Titles appear alphabetically on the following pages in this section.

### PERIODICAL INDEXES

Edmund B. Thomas Jr performed a huge service by making it possible to access the information in some precancel periodicals. Using the extensive library of Manley L. Behrens, Thomas created an index to the content in eleven precancel journals from 1940 to 1980. This index was originally published in *The Philatelic Literature Review*, and subsequently reprinted by Dilmond D. Postlewait. With a bit of searching, one may be able to find a copy of one of these. The titles covered by the index are:

Postlewait subsequently created and published an index to the next sixteen years, 1981-1997 of the *Precancel Forum*. As with the Thomas index, copies can probably be found with a bit of work. Don Rossman, during his tenure as *Forum* editor prepared indexes for 1997-2001. When Larry Patterson became editor of the *Forum*, he began preparing indexes, including a consolidated one for the years 2006-2016.

Published by the Arkansas Precancel Club. Monthly, except for a combined Jul-Aug 1944 issue. There was also a 1-page prospectus (dated Aug 1943) which preceded the first issue.

Last issue: Sep 1910

13 issues published

Published by F. Percy Collingwood. Official organ of the International Precancel Club starting with the Jul 1910 issue. This title was preceded by the *Attleboro Stamp Co. Monthly Bargain List*. Merged with *The Stamp Journal*.

The Attleboro privately perforated coils, which finally gained Scott catalog listing in the late 1990s, are said to have been used to mail the Sep and Oct 1909 issues -- as if one is likely to find these in their original wrappers!

Official bulletin of the Baltimore Precancel Club. Monthly from Jul 1938 through Jan 1940, a combined Feb-Mar 1940, issue followed by monthly issues Dec 1940 through Jul 1941. Other issues seen are Jan and Jul 1942. There was also an Aug 1939 convention extra for the PSS convention.

**BARGAIN COUNTER, THE (supplement to *The Texan*)**

This was an advertising supplement to *The Texan*. It is difficult to determine the publishing history as there are two typeset volumes with months but no year dates (vol. 1 nos. 1-11, and vol. 2 nos. 1-9). Also seen are Jan and Feb 1963 in a different format, in which the text mentions a format change, so it is assumed these are later than the two volumes mentioned above.

42 issues published

Published by the Kentucky Precancel Society. Mostly four times a year through 1998. Eight issues 1999-2002; none in 2003-04; four in 2005-07.

**BOLETIN, EL**

First issue: undated, early 1954

Last issue: Jul 1961

45 issues published

Published by the New Mexico Precancel Club. Only two of the first seven issues had dates, but dates on vol. 1 nos. 5 and 6 make it possible to date the beginning of this title. The Jul 1961 issue was the last, carrying the news that the club would have a column in the publication of the New Mexico Philatelic Association.

**BOSTON BULL, THE**

First issue: Feb 1937

Last issue: May 1939

Published by Walter McIntosh, Jr. and Dot Kiley.

**BRANDING IRON, THE**

First issue: May 1960

Published by the Arizona Precancel Club. The first issue was untitled, and the Jun 1961 issue was a repeat of the May issue with a new date rubberstamped onto it. Beginning with Jul/Aug 1961, *The Branding Iron* was merged with *The Arizona Philatelist*, which had a column titled “The Branding Iron.”

Published by the Chicago Precancel Club. December 1959 was numbered 10; January 1960 was numbered 12.

**DATED NEWS**

First issue: Jan 1947

Published by E. L. Patterson. First four issues were January through March and August 1947, numbered 1 through 4; the only other issue seen is an unnumbered one for Mar 1952. The first four issues parallel *Bureau News* by the same publisher and were probably mailed together.

Published by the Dixie Precancel Club. 26 seen over the 16 year span – mostly in 1958 and 1959. The issues seen are to spread out to be able to determine what constitutes a complete run of this title.

Published by the Upstate New York Precancel Club. There are two separate series of this title.

**circa 1939**

Eight issues have been seen: May through August and October 1939; and three issues with no year dated February 25, April 28, and August 25.

**circa 1961-68**

Undetermined number of issues published

The second series begins in June 1961 and ran irregularly with monthly, bimonthly, and quarterly issues until the first quarter of 1968. The first six issues were headed “Upstate New York Precancel Club” The Dutchman name appeared on the 7<sup>th</sup> and following issues.

There were special issues for September 1959 and 1960. Additional information is needed to understand the publishing history of this title.

**EGYPTIAN PRECANCEL CLUB**

First issue: Nov 1969

Last issue: Dec 1978

86 issues published

Published by Kenneth McMath, official organ of the Egyptian Precancel Club (southern Illinois). Mostly monthly with a few bimonthly issues and skipped months.

**ESSCEEPEECE**

(originally **ESCEEPEECE**)

First issue: Mar 1938

Last issue: Sep 1969

357 issues published

Official organ of the Southern California Precancel Club. Published mostly monthly. Volume numbering jumps from 24 to 34 in June 1961 and is not corrected until January and March 1970 when it is changed first to 33 and then 34. Effective with the October 1969 issue the title is changed to *Southern California Precancel Club Official Bulletin*. The title is changed again, to *The Vinyl Touch*, effective with the October 1977 issue.

**EVERYBODY'S PHILATELIST**

First issue: Jan 1910

Last Issue: Oct 1917

Published by John Milton Holt, MD. This title is included because it was the official organ of the International Precancel Club beginning with the April 1913 issue through the end of its run.

**EXTRA LEAVES**

There is only a single undated issue, published by W. C. Ogden to distribute updates to the Florida state catalog of 1956.

**FLORIDA RAMBLER, THE**

First Issue: No month indicated but 7 issues in 1957

Last issue: still in publication

Undetermined number of issues published

Published by the Florida Precancel Club. Like a number of other club bulletins, this one has periods of irregular publication and missing issues. However, other than the early 60s and again in the early 80s, monthly or bimonthly publication was reasonably regular until 2008 when three issues per year became the norm until a two issue per year schedule was adopted in 2017. One issue each appeared in 2020 and 2021

**GOLDEN GATE PRECANCEL SOCIETY BULLETIN**

First issue: Jan 1933

Last issue: Jul – Sep 2016

Number of issues published not determined

As of 2021, this is the longest running precancel publication, in publication over 80 years before the run ended. If nothing happens, *The Precancel Forum* will break that record in 2024. Mostly monthly from its inception until the early 1980s when it became mostly bimonthly. Only one issue in 1986, three each in 1987 and 1988, and information lacking about the early years of WWII – otherwise issued quite regularly.

The earliest known copy of the *Kansas Precancel News* is June 1955 and numbered no. 84.

Issued as an advertising supplement to the *Kansas Precancel News*. The first seven or 8 were titles *KPS Sunflower Special*. Later numbering on this is strange – the June 1970 issue is No. 87, the August issue is 175, which coincidentally is the same number as that issue of the *Kansas Precancel News*. This lends weight to the suspicion of imaginary predecessors, given that the first *Booster* would have appeared at about the time the *News* first appeared – even though the first known issue of the *News* is identified as “number 84”.

Official organ of the Kansas Precancel Society. The first issue is numbered 84, and the masthead claims predecessor journals, which probably do not exist (see *Jayhawk Precancelist*, *Kansas Precancel Stamp Club News* and *Kansas Precancel Bulletin*). Regularly published six times a year from inception until a break with no issues in 1989 and 1990. Four issues published in 1991, ending with Jul./Aug. There are a few anomalies encountered in the whole numbers assigned, which are resolved with the correct number on the very last issue.

**KANSAS PRECANCEL STAMP CLUB NEWS**

This title may not exist. Not a single copy has been seen. See discussion under listings for *Jayhawk Precancelist* and *KPS Sunflower Booster*.



**KEYSTONER, THE**

First issue: Sep 1948

Official organ of the Western Pennsylvania Precancel Society. Irregular publication – 59 issues in the first 8 years – until 1956 when regular monthly publication begins. In 1981 the frequency changes to 11 annually with a combined November and December issue. In 1986 the frequency drops to 10 with the June and July being combined. The final year, 1993, had six bimonthly issues and a special memorial issue for Wilfred Valimont and Marlin Herbert. While the last issue is numbered 484, the total number published is at least five higher due to incorrect numbering.

**LAWRENCE BROTHERS AUCTION BULLETIN**

The Lawrence Brothers can probably best be described as “characters” of the precancel boom of the 1920s and 1930s. They published an “official” bureau catalog and journals with names that sometimes mirrored prominent precancel journals, the Gazette for instance. They were probably viewed as annoying upstarts, or whatever term applied in the early decades of the century. By the 1950s they had moved on to coins. Federal prosecution and serving time are mentioned, but no definite information is known. Writing their biography would probably be an interesting undertaking.

This title, the next four in this list and *The Precancel Magazine* all appear to be tied together in sequence and for the most part, in numbering. It is still difficult to determine what the publishing history is, so the detail for these listings will consist of what has been seen to date.

Hugh C. MacDonald operated the New Town Precancel Club, which existed prior to the change in postal regulations allowing collectors to write in for precancels. For a fee per stamp, collectors received mailings from a variety of businesses in the towns of mailing, under several mailing operations that MacDonald ran. Some of the mailings had advertising, some were various issues of the *New Town Journal*. The postal inspectors were always trying to shut the “club” down and notices appeared in regional Postal Bulletins warning postmasters not to issue permits to other than local patrons. Nonetheless, mailings were made from hundreds of towns.

This is another title that is difficult to organize. Issues seen are dated from 1957 through January 1960, and bear issue numbers in volumes 1 through 4. The numbering is not always consecutive.

There was a two page "special edition" in addition to the regular Jan/Feb 1928 issue, a one page supplement to the Jul/Aug 1928 issue, a two page supplement to the January 1931 issue, and postcard supplements to the October 1940 and January 1941 issues. The January 1940 supplement announced the sale of the *Bee* to Adolf Gunesch. Some issues have been seen with more than one cover color.

A one sheet prospectus preceded the initial issue. A few issues appear with more than one cover color. The October 1958 issue, at 56 pages, the largest ever published, comes with and without the word “Sample” printed on the cover – it received wide distribution outside the PSS membership.

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## INTRODUCTION

The basis for this listing was a large accumulation of auction lists and catalogs assembled by Manley Behrens over several decades and a much smaller lot the compiler had gathered. These two lots were sorted out in late 1984, at which time the first draft of this list was prepared. It has been updated and added to as new items appeared. As with the other sections of this bibliography, the basic ground rule was to list only those items actually seen. There are obviously sale dates, and probably auctioneers, beyond those listed.

This is a listing of auction catalogs or lists that were prepared as separate documents. Thus, auctions that always appeared as part of a publication, such as in *The Precancel Bee*, are not listed. Those that were mailed as supplements to a publication are listed (e.g. Charles Heppner's lists which were mailed as supplements to the *Golden Gate Precancel Society Bulletin*). The exceptions are auctions that were usually separate documents, but infrequently appeared in publications, these are listed -- the name and date of the publication appears on the line before the sale number and date.

The listing is arranged alphabetically by auctioneer. The sale number and date are given as shown on the auction list or catalog. In the few instances where prices realized are known to exist, this is noted by indicating "PR" under the sale date.

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## INTRODUCTION

The first album pages produced especially for precancels were a series of 48 city sections published by B. Gordon Bushnell between 1916 and 1919. Since then there have been a number of albums and pages produced for various areas of precancel collecting. In recent years, the proliferation of computers has greatly expanded the variety of pages available, especially for towns and types. This compilation does not include these various made-to-order pages.

This section lists precancel related albums, pages and binders that have been seen. The listing also includes some collectors' personal pages as well as printed checklist forms and is organized into the ten categories shown in the Table of Contents. Unless there is specific mention of a different size or format, a binder or that the album is bound, the listing is for loose-leaf pages 8 ½ x 11 inches in size.
